Sub: Implementation of Amrit Bharat Station Scheme for Indian Railways
**Ref. : Railway Board letter of even number dated 23.12.2022, 26.12.2022,
31.12.2022, 31.01.2023, 17.02.2023**

Instructions for execution of Amrit Bharat Station Scheme have been issued vide above ref. letters and zonal Railways are required to prepare detailed plans for execution of the works. Since the volume of work is going to be very large and will require expert architectural and urban/traffic planning inputs, it has been decided that a team should be set-up at RLDA to assist the Railway Board in examining the proposals and/or to assist zonal railways through standardization of layouts and designs. RLDA is already setting up a DDC and MIS for this purpose, which may be expedited. RLDA is suggested to take up the following further works:

1.0 To set-up a unit comprising urban designers, traffic planners and construction experts to examine the compliance of plans being made under Amrit Bharat Scheme to the laid down policy guidelines and the local contexts.

2.0 To finalise and submit to Railway Board, a compendium of good design examples of traffic planning, passenger circulation and station layout planning for circulation to all zonal railways in hard copy. The designs and drawings of already approved station works may be taken as reference for this purpose.

3.0 To expeditiously finalize and submit to Railway Board, the modular design handbook in hard copies for circulation to all zonal railways in hard copy.
