Sub: Location of platform shelters

It has been noted that at many stations platform shelters are located at a distance from the foot-over-bridge landings thereby exposing the passengers to the vagaries of weather.

The Board desire that care must be taken while locating a new platform shelter so that, as far as possible, it is located in front of the station building and a continuous cover is provided for the passengers upto the foot-over-bridge. Wherever, the foot-over-bridges are provided with a cover and an uncovered portion of platform exist between the bridge and the cover shed, either the shed should be extended up to the foot-over-bridge, or in case the provision of this additional shelter is not justified as per the prescribed norms, provision of a covered walkway between the existing shelter and the foot-over-bridge should be programmed for construction.
