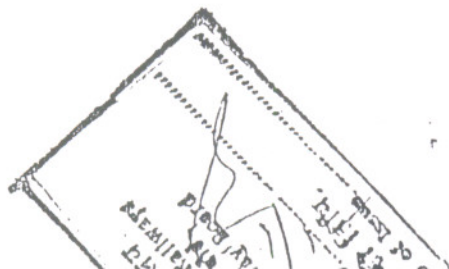
Sub: Use of Kota stone flooring at Stations.


Ref: Board's letter no. 93/LM(B)/2/164 dated
2.11.93 conveying Minutes of the Meeting
held on 19.10.1993 to review the Passenger
Amenity Works.

Vide the above referred Minutes, it was desired that at important stations, where large volume of traffic was being handled, Railways should plan to provide Kota stone flooring in the concourses and the main platforms, as this type of flooring was easy to maintain and looked better. It was also emphasized that before undertaking such works it must be ensured that all the trollies plying at the station are provided with rubber-tyred wheels.

It is desired that these instructions be brought to the notice of all concerned and their implementation ensured.
