Sub: Facilities for handicapped persons at the stations.

Extract from a letter received from the Managing Director Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India (A Government of Undertaking) is reproduced below suggesting provision of facilities for the handicapped by slight modifications/additions, alterations:-

- "1. Provision of ramps for easy entry of Wheel Chair at main entrance.
2. Provision of at least one public telephone at the Railway Station at suitable height for a person on a Wheel Chair to be able to use it conveniently.
3. Provision of at least one Water tap/Wash basin on each platform at a suitable height for a person in Wheel Chair to be able to use the same.
4. Provision of urinals/latrines in level with the platform.
5. Provision of suitable sign posts wherever these facilities have been located. A photocopy of the sample is enclosed."

2. This may please be kept in view and provided while carrying out repairs or additions/alterations at the stations. It may be mentioned here that special facilities for the handicapped are provided by all developed countries at public premises such as Rly. Stations/Air-ports etc.

3. A photo-copy of the internationally adopted sign where special facility for the handicapped is provided is attached.
